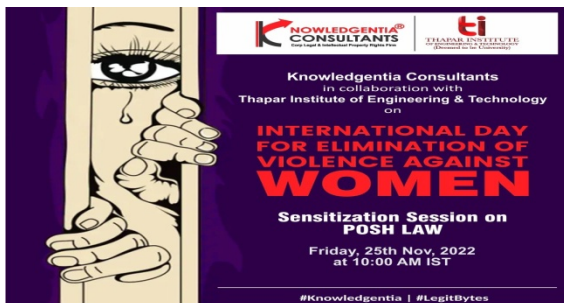
**KNOWLEDGENTIA JOINS HANDS WITH

Delhi government has launched first ever Mahila Mohalla clinics to cater to women and children less than 12 years for gynecology related issues. In the case titled, FDC Limited v. Nilrise Pharmaceuticals Pvt Ltd. and Anr., 2022 LiveLaw (Del) 1040, Delhi High Court has held that in case of medicinal products, the test for comparison of two trademarks is far stricter than as applied to other goods because any kind of confusion can lead to public injury. This was held in a trademark infringement suit where interim injunction was granted in favour of plaintiff company's mark ZIPOD. In this case the defendant company's mark ZOYPOD was observed to be phonetically similar to plaintiff's company mark ZIPOD. It was also ruled that once it is proved that the marks are deceptively similar and the plaintiff is prior adopter of the mark, the plaintiff is entitled to protection from infringement under Section 29 of the Trademarks Act.

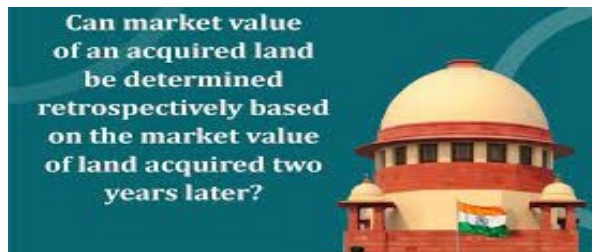

PURPOSE OF LAND ACQUISITION A RELEVANT FOR MARKET VALUE

The Apex Court while pronouncing judgment in a recent case titled S. Shankaraiah vs. Land Acquisition Officer and Revenue Divisional Officer Peddapali Karimnagar District, 2022 Live Law (SC) 934, has held that the purpose for which land acquisition is made is a relevant factor for determining market value. In this case, the court partly allowed the appeal. This case was filed because the land owners were not satisfied with the compensations awarded by land acquisition officer after acquisition by State Government. The High while modifying the award, fixed compensation considering market value and deducting some amount towards developmental activity. The court held that when the acquisition is solely for the purpose of excavation of coal and the entire land is acquired on basis of estimates of coal reserve and entire land is to be mined with no requirement of any further developmental activity, then deduction of 1/3rd towards developmental activity by High Court is unjustified. Original claimants were also granted fair amount of compensation in this case.

WIPO LAUNCHES “GREEN TECHNOLOGY BOOK”

The New flagship publication- THE GREEN TECHNOLOGY BOOK, launched by WIPO is part of organization's longstanding efforts to ensure that innovation, technology and intellectual property are at the forefront of the fight against climate change. This book has been created in cooperation with partners Climate Technology Center and Network and the Egyptian Academy of Scientific Research and Technology. This book was released at United Nations Climate Change Conference (COP 27). This publication basically covers adaptation technologies that aim to reduce vulnerability and increase resilience to climate impacts, especially in developing countries where effects are most heavily borne.

NEW IP BORDER REGULATIONS IN SINGAPORE

Singapore's Ministry of Law made an announcement regarding New Intellectual Property Rights border enforcement measures where Singapore customs will now be empowered to seize goods suspected of

infringing geographical indications or registered designs upon the IPR holder's request. As per the new law, to initiate a seizure, the IPR holder must submit a written seizure request, along with the SGD200 (US\$146) fee. Further charges may be incurred for any service provided by Customs. For Customs to act on a request, the IPR holder must provide information on the goods; proof of IPR ownership; and appropriate security during goods seizure. Importers or exporters, as well as the IPR holders requesting seizure, will be notified that the goods have been seized. Goods will only be released if the IPR holder has not made any infringement action; if there is no court order banning goods release; and if the IPR holder gives consent.

**BLOCKING OF STREAMING APP
“PIKASHOW”**

Delhi High Court in a case titled Star India Pvt Ltd and Another Vs. PikaShow Application and Ors.; ordered blocking of a mobile streaming application PikaShow after Star India filed a suit for copyright. This case had been filed for copyright infringement by streaming app for providing content of all OTT platform for free. Since blocking of URL was not sufficient to stop the application from streaming content, the decision to block off whole app was taken. The court has also ordered all advertisers on the app to disclose all details including contacts, bank accounts, payments made or sale agreements entered into with the app. The domain name too has been ordered to be blocked as an interim measure.

**VIR DAS FOR COPYRIGHT
INFRINGEMENT**

An FIR under Copyright Act was registered against three directors namely Vir Das, Anurag Shrivastav and Girish Talwar along with Netflix for copyright infringement. Vir Das has been under fire lately and caught up in a string of controversies for passing derogatory remarks on women, Prime Minister Modi and India at his show in Washington DC. Entering into agreement with producer to release the show and backsliding in his commitments thereafter has further put his reputation under jeopardy.
