



### PRINCIPLE BASED DIGITAL INDIA ACT

The draft bill for Digital India Act that will replace existing Information Technology Act,2000 is slated to be rolled out soon. This bill is specifically aimed at helping India take the lead as a trillion dollar digital economy. The new law will provide strict action against misinformation, disinformation and child sexual abuse. First public consultation with industry experts and other stakeholders with respect to bill has already been held. The current laws have many limitations such as comprehensive provisions on user rights, trust, security, limited recognition of new forms of cybercrime, lack of mechanism to regulate harmful and illegal content, lack of appropriate principles on data protection.

### DELHI HIGH COURT PULLS UP ASSISTANT CONTROLLER FOR CUT AND PASTE ORDER

In the case titled **Dolby International AB v.**The Assistant Controller of Patents & Designs, 2023 LiveLaw (Del) 238, the Delhi High Court has held that orders refusing application for grant or rejection of a patent must not be passed in a mechanical manner but after due application of judicial mind. Granting and rejecting a patent being a serious matter, any kind of unreasonable delay in granting a patent can lead to reduction in residual life leading to disinclination for inventors to invent new methods, products and processes.

# US COPYRIGHT ISSUES GUIDELINES FOR AI GENERATED WORK

US Copyright law mandates requirement of Human Authorship to secure a copyright. Thus, the work must be a product of human creativity even if it indulges AI-technology for generation of any work. Guidelines for copyright applications involving AI -generated materials include applicants to have a duty to disclose the inclusion of AI-generated content in a work submitted for registration and provide a brief explanation of the human author's contribution towards the work. Further, Individuals using AI technology in their creation may claim copyright protection for their contributions using the Application, Standard providing brief statement in the 'Author Created' field. There must be no enlisting of an AI technology or the company that provided it as an author or coauthor, if only it was used for creating their work. There must be exclusion of AI-generated content from the application that is more than de minimis. Applicants who are not thorough with the application form may simply provide a general statement that the submitted work contains AI material. How frontier technology shapes and mould the IP laws in each country will depend on the prevailing local and infrastructure conditions.
